Citycon requires by written agreements that such third parties keep the transferred personal data confidential and adequately secure.</p> <p>Such third parties include: the IT service providers and data processors enabling the execution of the invest related information.</p>   |
| <p><b>International transfers of personal data</b></p>          | <p>Citycon may store and/or transfer personal data to its affiliates and partners in and outside of EU/EEA member states and the United States in accordance with mandatory legislation.</p>  |
| <p><b>Retention of personal data</b></p>                        | <p>Citycon does not use, store, keep or otherwise retain personal data for a longer period than is necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, unless required otherwise by local laws.</p> <p>Contact information will be stored as long as the user relationship exists.</p> <p>Unless required otherwise by local laws, personal data is deleted without delay when it is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it has been collected and when the legitimate reason for the processing of such data no longer exists.</p> |
